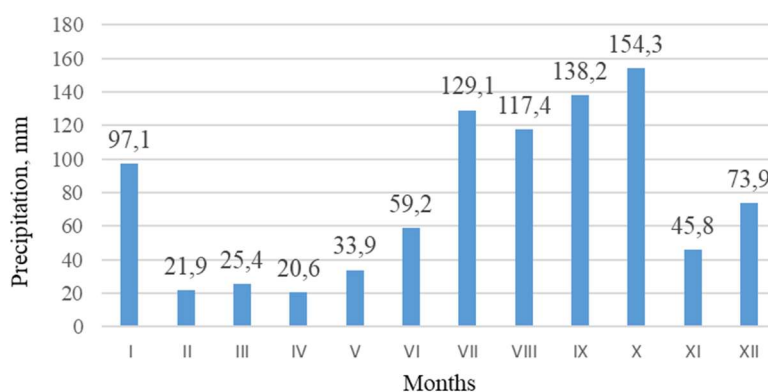


Fig. 1. Distribution of precipitation

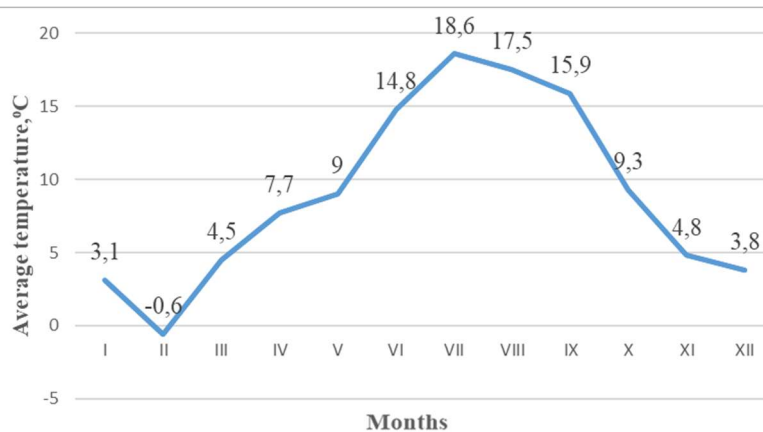


Fig. 2 Average air temperature
